**Brookfield Subdivision** – Al Spaziano came with associate Michael Montalto and they are interested in modifying approved phases of completion. Al has concerns regarding funding for the senior living portion of the project. Would like to delay that phase. Discussion about the water mains. Much dialog on specific zoning, phases and timelines. It has been decided that both parties will come back with more info for next meeting.

<u>Highway Department Report:</u> Highway Superintendent Robert Viscardi requested permission to hire 1 MEO. The Town budgeted for 10 employees for 2020 and has been operating with 8.

Assessors Report: Since being re-assessed in 2019, Clarkson sales are coming in at 5% or above assessed value. 166 total sales from July 10, 2019 – present. 118 are residential. 66 land. Clarkson will be hosting the next Assessor's Meeting on Nov 18 at Kimball Lodge. Elderwood filed article 7 and commercial consult meeting with Elderwood is moving forward.
